College Advising Corps is excited to announce the 2017 Peter and Laurie Grauer True North award. In honor of Mr. Grauer's exceptional leadership as our Founding Board Chair, College Advising Corps will annually recognize a second year adviser who has demonstrated impact, grace, humility, leadership, and most of all the ability to guide students and fellow advisers in a way that makes College Advising Corps a better program.

The Peter and Laurie Grauer True North Award recipient will have made a significant impact on the College Advising Corps through outstanding dedication, passion, exceptional performance, excellent service to students, and ingenuity, as demonstrated by one or more of the following:

- Exemplary Achievements and Performance
 - Consistently and substantially exceeds expectations, performs at a level above and beyond the call of service; has made important and significant contributions to their community; contributes and demonstrates commitment to the College Advising Corps mission and core values.
- Excellence in Service
 - Consistently and substantially demonstrates an ability and willingness to work positively, respectfully, and effectively with others; demonstrates ability and willingness to manage changes in work priorities, procedures, and organization; demonstrates exceptional ability to foster collaboration, communication, and cooperation among school partners, fellow advisers, and members of the College Advising Corps community.
- Outstanding Dedication to Student Success
 - Significantly improved or increased college access indicators; consistently seeks to improve the quality service; demonstrates efforts to expand responsibilities.

Program Directors can nominate one (1) second-year adviser from the 2017-18 program. Nomination materials should consist of a nomination form and one (1) narrative letter of support.

The True North Award Selection Committee consists of members of the College Advising Corps Board of Directors.

The selected adviser will be recognized at the annual Adviser Summit and, in addition to the recognition, the College Advising Corps will match the adviser's education award in the amount of \$5,815. The education award match may be used to pay educational costs at eligible post-secondary educational institutions, as well as to repay student loans.

Nominations must be received by Friday, October 27th, 2017. Nominations will only be accepted via email as a **single** scanned pdf attachment to Katrina Thompson, Operations and Events Coordinator, kthompson@advisingcorps.org. Late applications will not be accepted.
